1. Participation is open to all GBPA and Government licensees in good standing (proof will be required).
2. Entry is free, no cost or fees apply.
3. Employees of GBPA and Government organizations are also eligible to participate.
4. Contest is for roundabout decorations only.
5. Judging will be based on "curb appeal."
6. Judging criteria will include [a] Unique design and creative use of lights and decorations; [b] Storyline or theme; [c] Display and placement of decorations (use of roundabout), animated objects, etc.; and [d] Overall presentation. [e] Resident Choice. The standard must be of high quality.
7. Judging will be done from 7:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.
8. Participants should ensure that all lights, animations, and decorations are in place and activated for the judging periods on both nights.

8. Participants should ensure that all lights, animations, and decorations are in place and activated for the judging periods on both nights.
